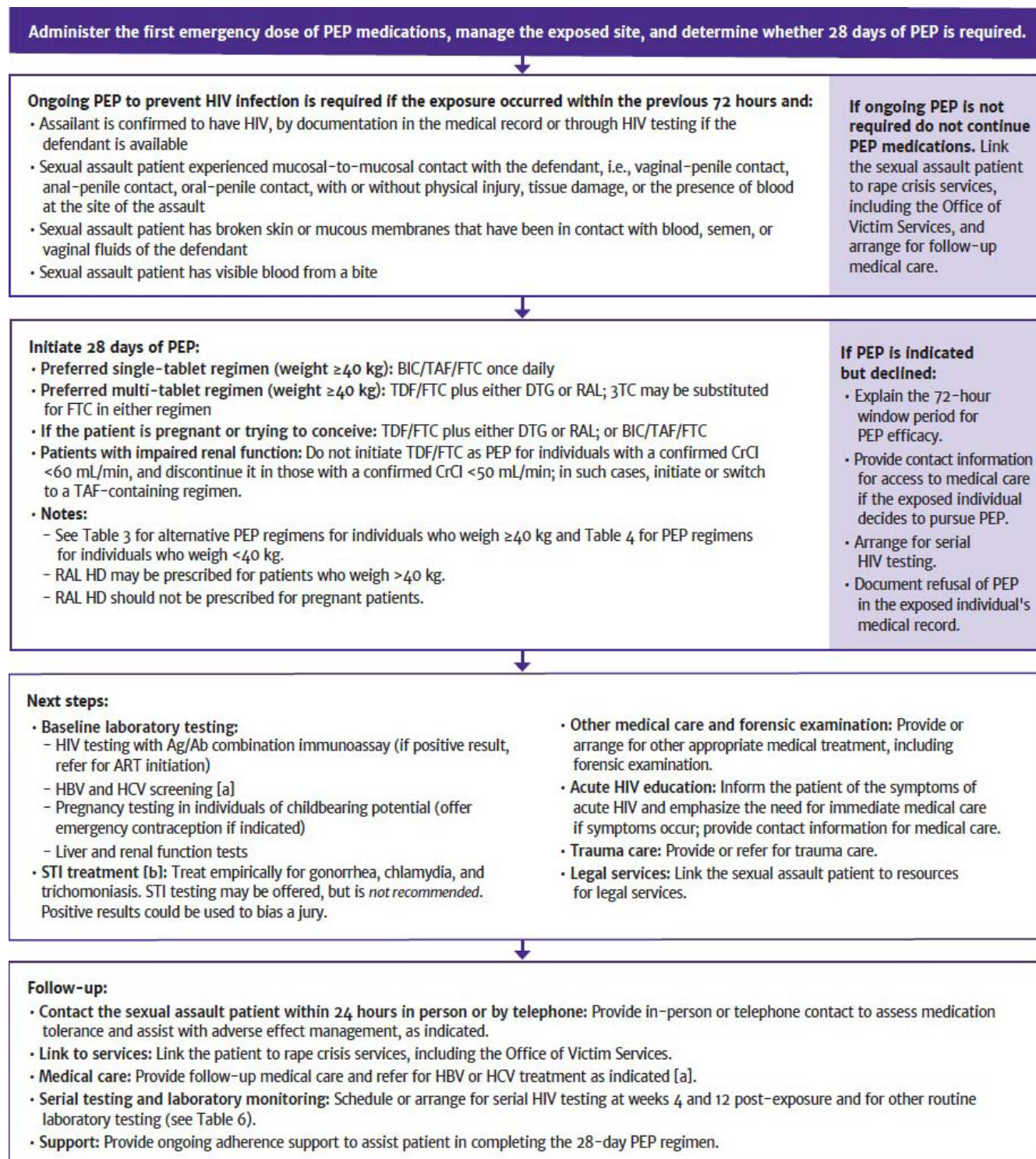


Figure 4: Sexual Assault HIV Exposure in Adults: Post-Exposure Prophylaxis and Exposure Management
